



## Harmonised GGS data set and report

### Introduction

Much of the significant micro-level modelling to be conducted as part of the REPRO project uses data from the Generations and Gender Project (GGP).<sup>1</sup> These data are commonly described as GGS (Generations and Gender Survey) data. GGS data will mostly be used in Work Package 3, which applies micro-level modelling of fertility decision making. This Deliverable (3.7) is the first documentation output associated with REPRO Work Package (WP) 3.

GGS data are collected from several countries in successive three-year waves. REPRO WP3 will conduct a comparative cross-sectional analysis on data gathered from nine countries (Bulgaria, Russia, Georgia, Germany, France, Hungary, Italy, the Netherlands and Norway) in the first wave. In the first six countries of interest, data were collected in purpose-specific household surveys. These data are available from the Population Activities Unit at the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE). The approach differed in Italy, the Netherlands and Norway where selected GGS questions were incorporated in surveys that had a broader scope.

The GGS data of particular interest for REPRO are those collected in Section 6, Fertility.<sup>2</sup> Additional data are needed to identify respondents in different groups of interest and for analyses associated with developing adequate measures of factors associated with fertility decisions. While most of these data are directly available from other sections of the GGS, some variables—most notably, parity, measuring the number of children a respondent already has—had to be calculated so that our work on REPRO could proceed.

The harmonisation goal was to prepare a single database which contained comparable data for all available countries and for all GGS variables that will be used in REPRO. Data from Norway were excluded from this joint database for privacy reasons. Data from the other eight countries have been harmonised in the manner described below.

### Availability of the GGS dataset

The harmonised GGS dataset is provided to the REPRO-partners as well as to the wider public under the condition that they apply for it at the UNECE following the usual application procedure for GGS datasets. The SAS syntax will be made publicly available on the website.

## Harmonisation process

The harmonisation process was organised in three stages:

1. A table of relevant GGS variables was developed to guide the harmonisation. This table was reviewed by the participants of the REPRO workshop held in Milan in May 2008, after which some minor changes were made.
2. As a first step in producing the harmonised database, the current versions of the GGS data files of all countries for which preliminary harmonised data were already available (i.e. Bulgaria, France, Georgia, Germany, Hungary and Russia) were combined in a single database. Some differences between coding for different countries were identified, and these differences were resolved through recoding (see syntax at the end of the report). New variables critical for the REPRO project (e.g., parity) were then calculated.
3. In the final stage, data from Italy and the Netherlands were added to the database. However, data from these countries were gathered in a different way to data from the other countries, with differences both in questionnaire and sampling design. A subset of variables to be included in the harmonisation was identified and then recoded to match the original set of countries. The Italian data file needed a deeper harmonisation process, involving the reconstruction of childbearing history and other variables. Since the Italian data were drawn from a household survey of all family members, all household members aged 18-64 are included. The Dutch data are substantially incomplete with regard to several of the critical variables for the REPRO project.

Please find frequency tables for original and recoded variables in all eight countries in the Appendix.

## Details of the harmonisation

The harmonisation process treated variables in groups associated with the role that the variables play in the REPRO analyses. The table at the end of this section summarises the availability of variables in the first four groups which are those required to conduct an analysis according to the Theory of Planned Behaviour, the framework which guides the research in REPRO Work Package 3. The syntax used to recode harmonised variables is found at the end of the report.

### Intentions

This group contains information on:

- Intention in the "next 3 years",
- Intention "now",
- Long-term intention,
- Total number of intended children,
- Behaviours indicative of intention (methods that help to get pregnant and current and past method to prevent pregnancy),
- Intention to adopt.

The coverage of these variables among countries is complete or nearly complete for Bulgaria, Russia, Georgia, Germany, France while it is only partially so for Hungary, Italy and the Netherlands. For these latter countries we are lacking information, in particular the data about methods helping to get pregnant and current and past methods to prevent pregnancy as well as intention to adopt.

Specifically the harmonisation has involved the following variables:<sup>3</sup>

### *Fertility intentions:*

- Short-term (a622) and long-term (a624) fertility intentions were transformed from 4-scale variables (definitely not, probably not, probably yes, definitely yes) into dichotomous variables (yes/no) in order to be comparable also with Hungary. The new variable names are a622r, a624r. The original variables were retained for all countries for which they were available.
- Want another baby now (a611) was coded 'yes', 'no', 'not sure' in all countries except Hungary which also included 'physically impossible to have a child'. This last response was recoded into 'no'. The new variable name is a611r. It is not available for Italy and the Netherlands.
- The total number of intended children was asked separately to pregnant women or men whose partner was pregnant (a630) and to people who were not pregnant (a626). This distinction is not present in Germany, France, Italy and the Netherlands. A new variable was created to contain the responses from these countries along with the combined responses to the two original variables. The new variable name is totnch.
- Methods that help to get pregnant include a list of different medical treatments in each country. A new dichotomous variable (yes/no) was created and is available with the exception of Hungary, Italy and the Netherlands. The new variable name is a618r.
- Current and past (in case of pregnancy) contraceptive methods (a620, a609) include a list methods used to prevent pregnancy. Two separated dichotomous variables were created for current (a620r) and past (a609r) contraceptive use. Moreover, a combined binary variable for contraceptive use (either current ones or current pregnancy) plus four more variables for each single kind of contraceptive method were introduced. The new variable names are ccept (uses or used contraception), cceptcond (condom), cceptdia (diaphragm, cervical cap, foam, cream, jelly, suppositories), cceptpill (pills/IUD/injectables/Depo-Provera), cceptnat (Natural: Persona/"morning-after pill"/withdrawal/safe period). Contraceptive use is not available for Hungary, Italy or the Netherlands.
- Intention to adopt or to take a foster child, asked for people with (a631) and without (a623) pregnancy, has been put into a unique variable. The new variable name is adopt. It is not available for Italy and the Netherlands.

### **Attitudes**

The variables in this group concern attitudes to outcomes of having children (e.g., effect on financial situation, effects on relationships), supplemented by variables that measure beliefs about the role of children in caring for their parents. Data for this section were mostly gathered using the same 5-point scale and the same set of variables. Differences are:

- For the Netherlands, only data on the role of children in caring for parents are available.
- For Italy, the effect of having another child on the care and security one may get in old age is missing.
- The role of children in caring for parents is included for Bulgaria, Russia, Georgia, Germany, France and Hungary, while in Italy only the item on gender difference in caring responsibility is included; in the Netherlands gender differences and financial help are entirely omitted.

### **Subjective norms**

This section includes variables that measure respondents' perceptions of social pressure to have a child from people important to them along with some variables on partner agreement/disagreement. For most countries, the data are available on the same variable and using the same 5-point scale. Differences are:

- This section is not included in the Netherlands.
- For Italy, there are several differences: perceived partner agreement is not included nor is perceived pressure from relatives; perceived parental pressure, on the other hand, which is measured by in a single variable in the other countries is split into two variables measuring pressure from the mother and the father, respectively.
- In Hungary, couple disagreement within the last 12 months about having children (a408\_h) has slightly different scale answers, since the category 'seldom' is not included. A new variable where 'seldom' is coded into 'sometimes' has been created. However, in Hungary 'sometimes' is equivalent to an intermediate value (say 2.5) between categories 2='seldom' and 3='sometimes'.

### Perceived behavioural control

This group of variables includes

- respondent's and partner's physical ability to have a child,
- the possibility that having a child depends on a number of issues (financial situation, work, housing conditions, health, a suitable partner, the partner's/spouse's work or health, availability of child care, the possibility to go on parental leave) and
- the control in the next three years over one's own financial situation, work and housing conditions, health, the capability to make ends meet, satisfaction about one's current job and housing situation, and the relationship with the partner, the division of household chores, childminding provided by employers.

For the countries that include these variables, they are comparable. Differences are:

- In the Netherlands these items are empty with the exception of the satisfaction with relationship to partner (though in ordinal scale).
- In France there is no reference to "physical ability".
- In Hungary, with regard to the physical ability to have a child, only the respondents' ability is asked about, not their partners', and it is binary.
- In Italy the respondent's and partner's physical ability to have a child are not included; nor are all items on the dependence on having a child included (thus, having a suitable partner, partner's/spouse's health, opportunity to go on parental leave are missing); and the capability to make ends meet, satisfaction about housing situation, relationship with the partner, and in child care arrangements are not included either.
- In France, Hungary and the Netherlands the control in the next three years over one's own financial situation, work and housing condition and health are not included.

Specifically, the harmonisation involved the following variables:

- The respondent's and partner's physical ability to have a child (a612 and a616, respectively) were recoded in two dichotomous variables (a612r, a616r respectively) in order to provide comparability with Hungary.
- Satisfaction with relationship to partner (a407). where the satisfaction scale (numerical 0-10) was recoded into 4-scale (ordinal values) (a407r) in order to provide comparability with the Netherlands
- Creation of harmonised variables on respondent's and partner's physical ability to have a child (a612\_r4 and a616\_r4, respectively).

### Identification and "external" variables

#### Age

Age of respondents (ahg5\_1) is missing for 50 observations in Germany and 5 observations in Bulgaria.

#### Parity

Parity/number of children can be calculated in different ways depending on the information on co-resident children and non-resident ones. The constructed variables are the following ones:

Parity = co-resident children (1) + non-resident children (2)

Parityb = co-resident children (1) + non-resident children (2) + non-resident step-children (3)

Parityc = co-resident children (1) + non-resident children (2) + non-resident step-children who lived at home (4)

Parityd = biological co-resident children (5) + biological non co-resident children (6)

where **Parityd** ≤ **Parityc** ≤ **Parityb** and

the elements needed to build this parity are:

(1) **Co-resident children** are taken from: relationship to Respondents ahg3\_i in (2,3,4,5,6) i.e. including 2 - biological children with current partner or spouse; 3 - biological children with a former partner or spouse; 4- stepchildren; 5- adopted children; 6 - foster children.

(2) **Non-resident children** are taken from: a213\_i in (1,2,3,4)

1 - biological; 2 - adopted; 3 - foster 4 = adopted + foster in IT

- 2,3 do not exist in Bulgaria
- (3) **Non-resident step children** are taken from: a229\_i in (1,2)  
1 – male; 2- female
- (4) **Non-resident step children who lived at home** include a231\_i=1
- (5) **Biological co-resident children** are taken from: ahg3\_i in (2,3)
- (6) **Biological non co-resident children** include: a213\_i=1

In the Netherlands the variable biological children is constructed independently from the previous elements, but it is missing in the substitute sample (1,604 respondents).

In Italy it is unknown whether stepchildren lived at home, therefore parity cannot be calculated properly.

Parityd (all biological children) is present for every country.

*Level of attained education:*

It is possible to create 3 levels for attained education as follows

- a148r** 1 = 'Primary (up to compulsory)'  
2 = 'Secondary'  
3 = 'Tertiary'  
0 = 'No degree';

This classification is available for all countries but there are 1,428 records missing in the Netherlands (it might be possible to recover these variables at a later date) and 2,474 not applicable/non response in Russia.

The country-specific list from which this classification was obtained along with the SAS syntax follows:
